- From Dennis: The Town of Lee is working with SRPC to put together a Natural <u>Resources Inventory</u> (funded by a PREPA grant) with coordinator Lisa Murphy. There will be an organizational meeting on Wednesday 11/08 at the Town Office at 3 pm, it was suggested that it would be good to have representation from the LRWA on the committee, if you or another representative from Lee could attend it would be appreciated. Dennis accepted and will participate.
- Per NHDES, the <u>Epping WWTF exceeded its E. coli limit 6 times in late September</u> <u>into October</u> (sampled M/W/F each week.

From email chain,"I asked Dennis and he noted that, '*In today's meeting the Town indicated it was due to failed flat plate membranes, which reportedly have been removed from service since new hollow-fiber membranes were put on line 10/27/23.*'''

Epping WWTF sewer lagoons are being monitored to ensure adequate free-board (thus reducing the chance of releasing partially-treated sewage). Dry sludge is being removed.

- From Therese: Since moving to Raymond, I have been attending many Conservation Commission and Planning Board meetings. When I ask them if they are receiving the LRAC project review letters, both of these groups did not answer my question. Which tells me their answer is No. Suzanne is now emailing the Raymond Con. Com and PB our LRAC letters. I would like to talk to other members of LRAC about this.
- From Therese: The 60% Design Set for the Pawtuckaway Campground project has been posted on the ARPA project page, <u>NH State Parks American Rescue Plan Act Projects</u>.

The Division is proposing to do the following:

- Construct a new recreational vehicle dump station along the park road.
- Demolish and replace 5 toilet buildings in the Big Island and Horse Island camping areas.
- The project includes construction of new septic systems.
